

Incident Notification

Incident Date: January 13, 2017

Title: **3L of anhydrous ammonia Discharge**

Description: It was noticed in the morning that approximately 3 litres of anhydrous ammonia had spilled onto the road at the anhydrous ammonia off-loading station during the night-shift off-loading. Temperatures overnight dipped to -41.3C and averaged -36.1C. The consistently low temperatures kept the spilled anhydrous ammonia in liquid form, while under warmer conditions such as small amount would have dissipated as a gas.

Resolution: The affected ground was scraped up and the material was disposed of in the hydrocarbon land-farm. An investigation was initiated.

Effect: Potential effects on the environment will be negligible. There are no effects to worker/public health or safety.
